



ROSENQVIST STARTS MASTERS OF FORMULA 3 WITH FASTEST TIME

Swede Felix Rosenqvist (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport, 1:31.989 minutes) ended up first in first free practice of the RTL GP Masters of Formula 3, which is taking place at the 4.307 kilometres long Circuit Park Zandvoort this weekend. In bright sunshine, the current second-placed of the FIA Formula 3 European Championship ended up ahead of British trio Jordan King (Carlin, 1:32.153 minutes), Harry Tincknell (Carlin, 1:32.221 minutes) and Emil Bernstorff (Prema Powerteam, 1:32.227 minutes).

In the opening stages, Dennis van de Laar (Van Amersfoort Racing, 1:32.924 minutes) dominated proceedings after setting the provisional fastest time. Only after 15 minutes, the young drivers of Carlin and kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport toppled the Dutch driver from the top of the leaderboard. Just before the halfway-point, the order was Harry Tincknell from Jordan King, Michael Lewis (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport, 1:32.458 minutes), Sven Müller (ma-con, 1:32.526 minutes) and Nicholas Latifi (Carlin, 1:32.584 minutes). Then, Felix Rosenqvist, who won the Masters of Formula 3 two years ago, made his way up to the top and moved up into first place halfway through first free practice. After that, almost the entire field entered the pit lane for adjustments to the set-up to prepare for a final attack.

However, the order at the front remained unchanged: Rosenqvist's fastest time wasn't beaten. Thus, the Mücke driver remained fastest from King, Tincknell, Bernstorff, Lucas Auer (Prema Powerteam, 1:32.270 minutes), Alex Lynn (Prema Powerteam, 1:32.357 minutes), Luis Felipe Derani (Fortec Motorsports, 1:32.407 minutes), Tom Blomqvist (Eurointernational, 1:32.458 minutes), Lewis and Müller.

Second free practice is scheduled for this afternoon from 17.15 hrs while two qualifying sessions will be taking place tomorrow.
