27.09.2013. Free practice of the FIA Formula 3 European Championship took place in bright sunshine at the 4.307 kilometres long Circuit Park Zandvoort. Daniil Kvyat (Carlin, 1:31.006 minutes), a member of the Red Bull junior team, ended up fastest from Jordan King (Carlin, 1:31.217 minutes) and Felix Rosenqvist (kfzteile24 Mücke Motorsport).

With his fastest time of 1:31.006 minutes, Daniil Kvyat only just failed to crack the mark of 1:31 minutes. He was 0.211 seconds faster than his team-mate Jordan King, who was classified second. Behind Swedish driver Rosenqvist, Harry Tincknell (Carlin, 1:31.473 minutes) ended up fourth to make it three Carlin drivers in the top four positions. Jann Mardenborough (Carlin, 1:31.868 minutes), who is also competing for the British team, caused a brief interruption after sliding off the track and finished the session in 14th place.

Just behind Tom Blomqvist (Eurointernational, 1:31.589 minutes), Lucas Auer (Prema Powerteam, 1:31.602 minutes) was the best-placed driver of the Prema team in sixth position. After a pair of 40 minutes' free practice sessions, Alex Lynn (Prema Powerteam, 1:31.684 minutes) was just slightly slower than Auer. Alexander Sims (ThreeBond with T-Sport, 1:31.718 minutes), Felix Serrallés (Fortec Motorsport, 1:31.800 minutes) and Raffaele Marciello (Prema Powerteam, 1:31.810 minutes) rounded out the top ten. The Italian is currently leading in the drivers' standings and came to Zandvoort with a margin of 72.5 points over his main rival Felix Rosenqvist.

Local hero Dennis van de Laar (Van Amersfoort Racing, 1:31.845 minutes) was classified 13th while Mexican Alfonso Celis (Fortec Motorsports, 1:33.137 minutes) ended up 25th on his debut in the FIA Formula 3 European Championship.
