## Gabriele Minì leads the way in Melbourne

PREMA Racing's Gabriele Mini set the early pace in Melbourne as the Italian driver topped timesheets in Free Practice ahead of Qualifying thanks to a time of 1:33.225.

Minì proved to be the one to beat for the majority of the morning session with compatriot Leonardo Fornaroli his nearest challenger, ending up three-tenths off his time. PREMA teammate Dino Beganovic wound up third.

But at the start of proceedings, it was an all-PREMA top three as Mini hit the ground running with a lap of 1:34.874, leading Beganovic by three-tenths, as Arvid Lindblad tucked into third.

Soon after, Hitech Pulse-Eight's Cian Shields spun into the barrier at the final corner, bringing out the Red Flags after 15 minutes of running.

The drivers were back out on track with half of the session remaining and once again it was Minì who set the pace, strengthening his grip on P1 thanks to a 1:33.847. Trident's Fornaroli was now his closest challenger in second, two-tenths off the top.

The PREMA driver continued to post eye-catching times as he later crossed the line to complete a lap of 1:33.225, with Fornaroli once again in second, this time 0.345s behind.

With three minutes left in the session, another Red Flag was waved after ART Grand Prix driver Nikola Tsolov collided with MP Motorsport's rookie Alex Dunne. The Irishman ended up in the barriers, and the session was not resumed.

This left Minì with the fastest time with Fornaroli in P2 as Beganovic rounded out the top three.

Qualifying is scheduled for 14:00 local time at the Albert Park Street Circuit.

## NIKOLA TSOLOV HANDED THREE-PLACE GRID PENALTY IN MELBOURNE

22 March 2024



Following today's Free Practice in Melbourne, Nikola Tsolov has been handed a three-place grid penalty.

The ART Grand Prix driver collided with Alex Dunne on the run down to Turn 10, with the MP Motorsport racer ending up in the barriers near the end of the session, resulting in a Red Flag and bringing an early end to Practice.

After examining video evidence and listening to both drivers and Team Representatives, the Stewards determined that the actions of Tsolov, while unintended, caused a collision that was completely avoidable and therefore imposed a grid drop in accordance with previous precedent.

Dunne has also been reprimanded for his part in the incident by the Stewards after it was adjudged that he unnecessarily impeded Tsolov and potentially may have affected his lap.

Tsolov will serve the penalty in the next race in which he competes
